What is a Disease Management Nurse and how will the nurse help me become healthier?

A disease management nurse is someone that supports and builds a strong relationship with you to help guide you through your health care journey. You will be visiting with the nurse at least once a month to help you understand your conditions, set personal goals, and provide education to improve your health. The nurse will also communicate with your health care team to ensure you are receiving the best quality of care.

Will my medical information be shared with my employer?

Your medical and health information is private and protected. Your medical record will only be reviewed by the Retro Health Care Team.
